Important Notes Regarding This Reporting Form

- 1. Worksafe Tasmania must be notified at least 7 days before explosives are imported or exported into or from Tasmania.
- This requirement applies to all explosives (including fireworks) other than those classified as Class 1.6 under the Australian Dangerous Goods Code. (Refer Explosives Regulations, Part 7 - Records, r38& r39)
- 3. A monetary fine of up to 25 penalty units may apply where notification/recording is not undertaken.
- 4. Explosive Import Records (EIR) and Explosive Export Records (ERR) must be kept for at least 5 years.
- 5 Approved Ports and Explosive Limits (1 August 2010)
